## What is {TESS+}?

Telecommunications Security Standards [{TESS+}](#) was established in 2018 by the Inter-Agency Security Management Network ([IASMN](#)) and Emergency Telecommunications Cluster (ETC) as a UN service led by WFP that standardizes Security Communications Systems (SCS) for the United Nations Security Management System ([UNSMS](#)) and NGOs, providing field support and cost-effective solutions across sectors.

Ultimately, {TESS+} enables humanitarian staff to communicate securely and reliably in the field, ensuring operational safety.

### How {TESS+} Works

-  Request to deploy {TESS+} experts from the Designated Official, through UNDSS
-  Once approved, the {TESS+} team will assess the existing telecoms setup and identify security comms needs
-  {TESS+} deploys to the country where support is needed
-  During the deployment, {TESS+} provides training to strengthen local capacity
-  After deployment, the team monitors the system to ensure it runs efficiently
