


# REMOTE SECURITY OPERATIONS CENTRE




A **Remote Security Operations Centre (RSOC)** is a technological solution that enables staff in remote locations to communicate with the central SOC. An RSOC bridges multiple remote SOCs, VHF radio networks and other communications to a single monitoring location. **It is a game-changer in field security communications.**

## How does an RSOC work?



In **Ukraine**, the RSOC links to 18 field sites and 11 Remote-Site-on-Vehicles, covering an extended geographical scope and ensuring safety while on the road.


In **Somalia**, two interoperable RSOCs ensure robust redundancy and a solid backup.



## What makes an RSOC effective and cost-efficient?

An RSOC streamlines safety and maximises reliability and convenience by bringing all field communications into one **"always-on" 24/7 hub**. It removes the need for multiple local SOCs, cuts costs, maximises staffing and avoids access challenges.

**The result?** Simpler operations, stronger reliability, and faster support for teams wherever they work.
